

OCES PTO MEETING MINUTES <u>5–11-16</u>

Place: OCES Café Start Time: 6:35 pm End Time: 7:25 pm

<u>Welcome/Introduction</u>: Jean Ricciardella, President, welcomed all to the last PTO meeting of the year and thanked all parents and staff members for attending. She thanked all committee heads individually (Apologized, in advance, if anyone was accidentally not mentioned) for all of their help throughout the year to make the festivities at Oasis a possibility. You are so much appreciated and we could not have accomplished all that we did this year without your assistance and support. She introduced Julie Rozum – Co-President, Sharon Lee – Vice President, Melissa Portuondo – Treasurer, and Michelle Sargis – Secretary.

Technology Displays: Mr. Fennell organized a few displays of the technology items that were purchased with the \$30,000 profit from the Yankee Candle Fundraiser. He introduced 3^{rd} and 5^{th} grade students who demonstrated how they utilized the 3-D printers. (Five 3-D printers were purchsed) The third grade showed a molecular model of the water cycle, charms that could be given out to students as a reward for reading a series of books, and 3-D models of catapults. The fifth grade discussed and demonstrated how 3-D models could be made of designs that they create on Tinker Cad. (This is a cloud-based 3-D design and printing App) The students can choose designs that are already created, or they can start from scratch and create their own. The design model is sent to the 3-D printer and what they create prints into a tangible object. This demonstration was conducted on a 75" Promethean Flat Panel – Touch Screen TV. Oasis is looking into pulling the smart boards out of the classrooms and replacing them with these TV's. The Smart Boards are meant to last about 5 - 6 years, whereas the TV screeens will last approximately 30 years. All new technology pieces are compatible with these TV's. Parents were given the opportunity to walk around and observe the other technology displays: Little-Bits, Dash-n-Dot, Ozo Bots, and Cubelets.

President's Report: Jean stated that we will move directly into the Principal's report.

<u>Principal's Report</u>: Principal Hook advised that it's been an awesome year. We have done so much and there is still a lot to be accomplished.

- Graduation awards ceremony will be held on Thursday, June 9th at 9am in the OMS gym.

- Four new picnic tables were purchased by PTO. Two of them are already in the breezeway and the other two will be assembled soon.
- We had an awesome Boot Camp for the Anglers for Wounded Warriors.
- We received the news that the entire Charter School System was recommended for accreditation. The process is still ongoing. Notification will be made when it becomes official.
- Our first Spelling Bee will be Wednesday, May 18th.
- Open House for the 2016-2017 school year will be held on Monday, August 8th from 6:30 to 8:30 pm.
- Today, all staff had a special "Jeans for Jean" day to honor Jean Ricciardella.
- Together, as a school, we raised over \$20,000 for local charities this year!

Treasurer's Report: Melissa Portuondo provided the current bank balance as \$19,976.92 and reported recent transactions as follows: \$200 for Wounded Warriors, \$100 for 4 the Kids Foundation (5K), \$100 for Luau for Life (5K), and \$754.72 for picnic tables in the breezeway. We will have a few more transactions for field trips and teacher reimbursements. All books are available for viewing. An audit is done every year and we are proud to announce that the books have been clean for the last five years!

All bank books will be closed for the annual audit July 1, 2016 and will remain closed through July 31, 2016. Once the audit is completed, a signed statement regarding the findings will be signed by the OCES Principal, the President and Treasurer of the PTO. A copy is provided to the Principal. The original is filed with the financial records of 2015-2016. Jean Ricciardella and Sharon Lee will be removed from the OCES PTO bank account. Any debit cards will be cancelled and destroyed. Victoria Schwetje will be added to the account as the newly elected Treasurer. Assistant Principal, Christopher Fennell, will be added to the special fundraising account, which has included the rally and flats tournament. Principal Hook remains as second signature. These records are kept separate from OCES PTO's financial report as this is not monitored by the PTO, but by Principal Hook. The bank statements can be viewed by PTO to serve as a check and balance, if needed. These records are maintained and stored if needed for future reference.

<u>Recent Events</u>: Julie Rozum provided information about recent and upcoming events and a new fundraiser for next year.

- <u>Staff Appreciation</u> During Student Led conferences the PTO provided pizza and salad for the teachers.
