

OCES PTO MEETING MINUTES 3-15-16

<u>Welcome/Introduction</u>: Jean Ricciardella, President, welcomed all to the PTO meeting. She introduced Julie Rozum – Co-President, Sharon Lee – Vice President, Melissa Portuondo – Treasurer, and Michelle Sargis – Secretary.

<u>President's Report</u>: Jean discussed that the PTO is still very busy and stressed that what we do is for ALL of the children.

Thank you Jen Bice! She organized the Have a Heart Dance and fun was had by all. The children decorated hearts for our OCES Have a Heart Banner and made greeting cards, which were delivered to the Children's Hospital. The event raised \$350, which was matched by the PTO. \$700 was donated to help children with cancer.

Jean advised that the \$30,000 check from the Yankee Candle fundraiser was written. Mr. Fennell explained that the money was spent on the following items:

- Two i-pad charging carts.
- Additional memory for the teachers' computers.
- Little Bits These are electronic building blocks that snap together with small magnets and allow the students to make creative inventions.
- Three more 3-D printers.
- Cubelets Blocks that easily snap together to form robots and inspire children to become better thinkers with the different operations they develop.
- Toddler Dot Basic computer programming.
- Dot & Dash (Set of 10) Robotic program for K & up where they can program a robot to do whatever you command. Can work interactively with the i-pads.
- Protective cases for the i-pads.
- Reflex Math This is a game-based program that helps students 2nd grade and up develop fluency with their basic math facts.
