Authorization to Carry and Self-Administer Medication

Dear Parent/Guardian:

In order for your child to carry and administer his/her own medication your child must hand in this form with parts A and B fully filled out. Part C will be completed in the health office with your child. Your child must be able to answer the questions in Part C or he/she will not be permitted to carry or administer his/her own medication. This is for the safety of your child and others. This form must be filled out IN ADDITION to the parent and licensed prescriber's normal authorization form for administration of medication in school.
