FAST Testing/ Progress Monitoring

Florida Assessment of Student Thinking is a progress monitoring assessment for reading and math

It will be administered three times a year to pre-k to 10th grade students

FAST tracks a students progress in learning the reading and math Florida BEST (Benchmark for Excellent Student Thinking) Standards

OES A+ 2021-2022 Funds Distribution Version B

To be eligible for the compensation bonus an individual must have been an employee at Oasis Elementary South School during the 2021-2022 school year and be employed during the period the bonus is paid. The employee must have worked within the 2021-2022 school year to be eligible. The bonus is based on the amount of time employed. Ex. A full year equals one (1) full share. Less than a full year equals a half (.50) share for a teacher.

Employees who were terminated or left mid-year will not be included in the distribution.

Employees who retired and were present for the entire year but left prior to the start of the 2022-2023 school year will receive a .75 share. Employees can only fall into one category and receive one category's payment.

Employees who worked the entire 2021-2022 school year at Oasis Elementary South School but transferred to another City of Cape Coral Charter School for the start of the 2022-2023 school year will still be eligible for their full share.

\$1,200 will be put aside for be used for supplies to support student learning and any remaining funds will be used for classroom materials/supplies which support student learning.

The 4 categories are as follows –

- 1) Instructional (including Interventionist), SLP, Administration, Nurse (1 share)
- 2) Educational Para, Office Staff, Clinic, and Retired Teachers (.75 share)
- 3) School Social Worker, Long Term Subs (.50 share)
- 4) Cafeteria Staff (.25 share)
