# OES student Dress Code

Students in violation of the dress code will be sent to the clinic to receive a change of clothes. Students will receive three written notices to correct dress code violations. Students will receive a consequence for each violation thereafter following the Code of Conduct. <u>CLick here to view the Dress Code and approved vendors.</u>

- Fridays are spirit days, not a no uniform day. Jeans (with no holes) or jean shorts are permitted with a school polo or school t-shirt. No sweatpants, gym shorts, or leggings (as pants) are permitted.
- No light-up style sneakers are permitted. Slip-on shoes (VANS style shoes) are not permitted on PE days.

**Leggings:** Tight legging style pants are not permitted. Leggings may be worn underneath a uniform skirt, dress, or jumper. Leggings should be solid black, gray, white or navy, no patterns.

Students may only wear approved colors. If colors are not approved, even if they have the logo, they will be considered out of Dress Code.

# Clinic Policy

For the 2022-2023 school year there have been some updates to our health forms we want you to be aware of.

- Many of the required health related forms that families must review and sign before the start of school are available digitally via the <u>Focus Parent</u> <u>Portal</u>. A significant change this year is that parents/guardians MUST fill out a "Consent for Health Services" form for their child to receive ANY care in the school clinics. This is a new legislation signed into law for the state of Florida. It is imperative that you register for an account if you do not already have one to access these forms and view other important academic information about your student(s).
- Please note that without this signed form of consent, our staff Will Not be able to provide basic health services, including first-aid, for your child. Thank you for your assistance.

## Arrival Procedures

- You may not line up before 7:50 am
- Gates open at 8:00 am.
- Pay careful attention to our staff directing traffic.
- Be courteous to other drivers.
- Parking/Drop off in front of the OES office is reserved only for school buses. Please park in the parking lot if you need to go to the front office.

## Dismissal Procedures

- Early Dismissal: Students will not be dismissed/signed out after 2:45 pm.

#### • PM CAR LINE:

- Please do not line up before 3:00 pm.
- Car line will start at 3:30 pm.
- All cars will remain in PARK, until they have been given the signal to proceed.
- If there is lightning within 10 miles of school, car lines will be stopped until the threat has cleared. In the event of a weather issue, a Parent Square message will be sent to notify you of the procedure to follow.
- Remain in your vehicle at all times.
