What is the School Advisory Council?

The School Advisory Council (SAC) is a peer elected, collaborative team of people that work to improve student achievement, effective teaching in the classroom, and parent and community engagement in the educational process.

Who is on the SAC?

The SAC must include a simple majority of family members, along with the school principal, school staff, and community members.

SAC's have certain criteria they must fulfill:

- **1.** SAC must include all stakeholders: this includes the school principal, parents, school staff, and community members.
- **2.** SAC meetings must be focused around strategic conversations instead of fundraising or event planning. Strategic conversations require examining school data and brainstorming solutions to issues affecting the school. A SAC is an opportunity for parents, faculty staff, students, community members, and the school principal to collaborate, address issues, and develop strategies for strengthening the school and academic achievement.
- **3.** Members of SAC can be members of other school community groups.

What is the role of the SAC?

The role of the SAC is to develop and implement the School Improvement Plan, which includes education goals and strategies for improvement. These goals and strategies are based upon measurements of student progress.

What is a SAC member's role?

The SAC Member:

- Functions as a council member according to established procedures by making suggestions and recommendations representative of their constituents' views.
- Participates regularly in SAC meetings and carries out council assignments.
- Becomes knowledgeable about the resources of the school, community and the school's educational program.
- Serves as a communications link between the SAC, their constituent groups, the community and the school.
- Acts as a resource person for the SAC by making available specialized information:
 - 1. Assists in identifying resources
 - 2. Accepts assigned responsibilities for assisting in and coordinating the implementation of new programs.
